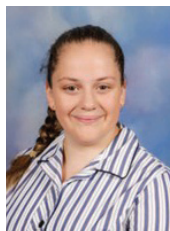
Corey Wakeman

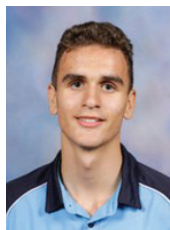

PEACE AND LOYALTY – HAROLD BODDY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

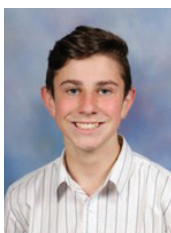
On behalf of Peace and Loyalty Lodge

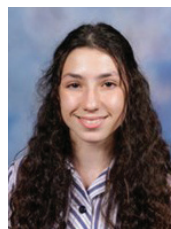
